**Sub: Consent to Operate** under Section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 21(4) of Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

**Ref:** Your application for Consent to Operate dated 09/11/2022 and subsequent correspondence.

Sir,

**Consent to Operate** under the provisions of Section 25/26 of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (hereinafter to be referred as the Water Act) and under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, (hereinafter to be referred as the Air Act) as amended to date and rules & the orders issued thereunder **is hereby granted** for your **(Run by Raman Educational Society) plant** situated at **NH-8, Delhi Jaipur Highway, Kotputli Jaipur Tehsil:Kotputli District:JAIPUR** , Rajasthan, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1 That this Consent to Operate is valid for a period from **09/11/2022** to **31/10/2027** .
- 2 That this Consent is granted for manufacturing / producing following products / by products or carrying out the following activities or operation/processes or providing following services with capacities given below:

- 3 That this Consent to Operate is for existing plant, process & capacity and separate Consent to Establish/Operate is required to be taken for any addition / modification / alteration in process or change in capacity or change in fuel.
- 4 That the quantity of effluent generation along with mode of disposal for the treated effluent shall be as under:

- 5 That the sources of air emissions along with pollution control measures and the emission standards for the prescribed parameters shall be as under:

- 6 This consent is not evidence for ascertaining entitlement of land.
- 7 That all safety measures, as per fire safety regulation, shall be installed in the hospital premises and permission for the same shall also be obtained from competent authority.
- 8 That this consent shall be subject to compliance of any direction or order passed by Court of Law in the matter.
- 9 That water consumption shall not exceed 10.5 KLD and proper record of water consumption shall be maintained.
- 10 That this consent is subject to validity of contractual agreement with CBMWTDF.
- 11 That the disposal of Bio Medical Waste through any unauthorized person/agency other than CBMWTDF is punishable under the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste Management (amendment) Rules, 2018 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.





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- 12 That Health care facility (HCF) shall dispose the municipal waste as per the provisions of Municipal Solid Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2016 and in no case Bio medical waste will be disposed with municipal waste.
- 13 That the liquid waste generated from the hospital activities shall be treated up to prescribed standards as prescribed under Bio-Medical Waste Management (amendment) Rules, 2018 and disposed as per the provisions of Water (Prevention and control of pollution) Act, 1974.
- 14 That Health care facility shall not construct building having more then 20000, Square Meter total built up area without obtaining prior EC from competent authority.
- 15 That the ground water abstraction shall not be carried out in contravention to the provisions/guidelines of Central Ground Water Authority, New Delhi, GOI.
- 16 That water flow meters shall be provided at the bore well to measure quantity of daily water consumption. Daily record of the same shall be maintained and to be submitted to this office.
- 17 Unit shall maintain adequately designed rain water harvesting structure for recharge of ground water in the premises.
- 18 That the domestic sewage generated shall be disposed off through septic tank & soak pit, that no effluent shall be discharged/disposed in cess pools inside/outside the premises.
- 19 That any incorrect information submitted in the consent application form or declaration shall make the HCF liable for legal action under section 42 of the Water Act and section 38 of the Air Act.
- 20 That proponent shall submit the detailed water balance with per bed water consumption & waste water generation.
- 21 That the hospital will submit permission for Establishment of hospital from JDA/Nagar Nigam/Municipality within 30 days.
- 22 That the HCF shall apply for renewal of consent to operate before 04 months from expiry of this consent.
- 23 That the project Proponent shall comply with provision of the Batteries (Management and handling) Rules, 2001 (as amended) and submit half yearly returns (as bulk consumer, importer, auctioneer, recycler as the case may be) to the State Board as provided under rule 10 (2) (ii) of the Battery (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001 (as amended). In case the Project Proponent is not a bulk consumer even then the used batteries shall be returned to the authorized dealers or recyclers only.





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- 24 That the record of batteries purchased and sold/returned to registered dealers and/ or authorized recyclers shall be maintained and made available to the officers of the Board during inspection.
- 25 That this consent to operate is subject to post audit/verification of pollution control measures and consent conditions. In case it is found during post inspection that the unit has flouted conditions of the consent and/or is having inadequate pollution control measures and/or unable to meet the prescribed standards, this consent will be revoked without any further notice in the matter.
- 26 That no Single Use Plastic (SUP) item, which is banned vide Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MOEF & CC), Government of India notification dated 12.08.2021 shall be used in the industry/unit premises.
- 27 That proponent shall obtain the necessary permission from the forest department, or other department/authority in concern if the hospital falls/comes under such area/ purview or scope of concern of forest, eco sensitive zone, conserved area and within the boundary limits of any national park, sanctuary or other area defined by the forest department, any authorities in concern time to time. The sole responsibility of obtaining the permission from the departments in concerns i.e. forest department, Wild Life Board or other departments is of project proponent. The project proponent shall ensure the operation of hospital only after obtaining the permission from the departments in concern (if applicable).
- 28 That, notwithstanding anything provided hereinabove, the State Board shall have the power and reserves its right, as contained **under Section 27(2) of the Water Act and under Section 21(6) of the Air Act** to review anyone or all of the conditions imposed here in above and to make such variation as it deems fit for the purpose of **Air Act & Water Act**.
- 29 That the grant of this **Consent to Operate** is issued from the environmental angle only, and does not absolve the project proponent from the other statutory obligations prescribed under any other law or any other instrument in force. The sole and complete responsibility to comply with the conditions laid down in all other laws for the time-being in force, rests with the industry/ unit/ project proponent.
- 30 That the grant of this **Consent to Operate** shall not, in any way, adversely affect or jeopardize the legal proceeding, if any, instituted in the past or that could be instituted against you by the State Board for violation of the provisions of the Water Act and Air Act or the Rules made thereunder.





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- 31 That the Project Proponent shall comply with provisions of the E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 and ensure that e-waste generated by them is channelized through collection centre or dealer of authorized producer or dismantler or recycler or through designated take back service provider of the producer to authorized dismantler or recycler.
- 32 That the Project Proponent shall maintain record of e-waste generated by them in Form-2 and make such records available for scrutiny by the Board.
- 33 That the Project Proponent shall file annual returns in Form-3, to the Board on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.
- 34 That the transportation of e-waste shall be carried out as per the manifest system whereby the transporter shall be required to carry a document (three copies) prepared by the sender, giving the details as per Form-6.
- 35 That the Project Proponent shall comply with provisions of the Batteries (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001 (as amended) and submit half yearly returns (as bulk consumer, importer, auctioneer, recycler as the case may be) to the State Board as provided under Rule 10 (2) (ii) of the Battery (Management and Handling) Rules, 2001 (as amended). In case the Project Proponent is not a bulk consumer even then the used batteries shall be returned to the authorized dealers or recyclers only.
- 36 That the record of batteries purchased and sold/ returned to registered dealers and/ or authorized recyclers shall be maintained and made available to the officers of the Board during inspections.

This **Consent to Operate** shall also be subject, besides the aforesaid specific conditions, to the general conditions given in the enclosed Annexure. The Project Proponent will comply with the provisions of the **Water Act and Air Act** and to such other conditions as may, from time to time , be specified, by the State Board under the provisions of the aforesaid Act(s). Please note that, non compliance of any of the above stated conditions would tantamount to revocation of **Consent to Operate** and Project Proponent / occupier shall be liable for legal action under the relevant provisions of the said Act(s).
